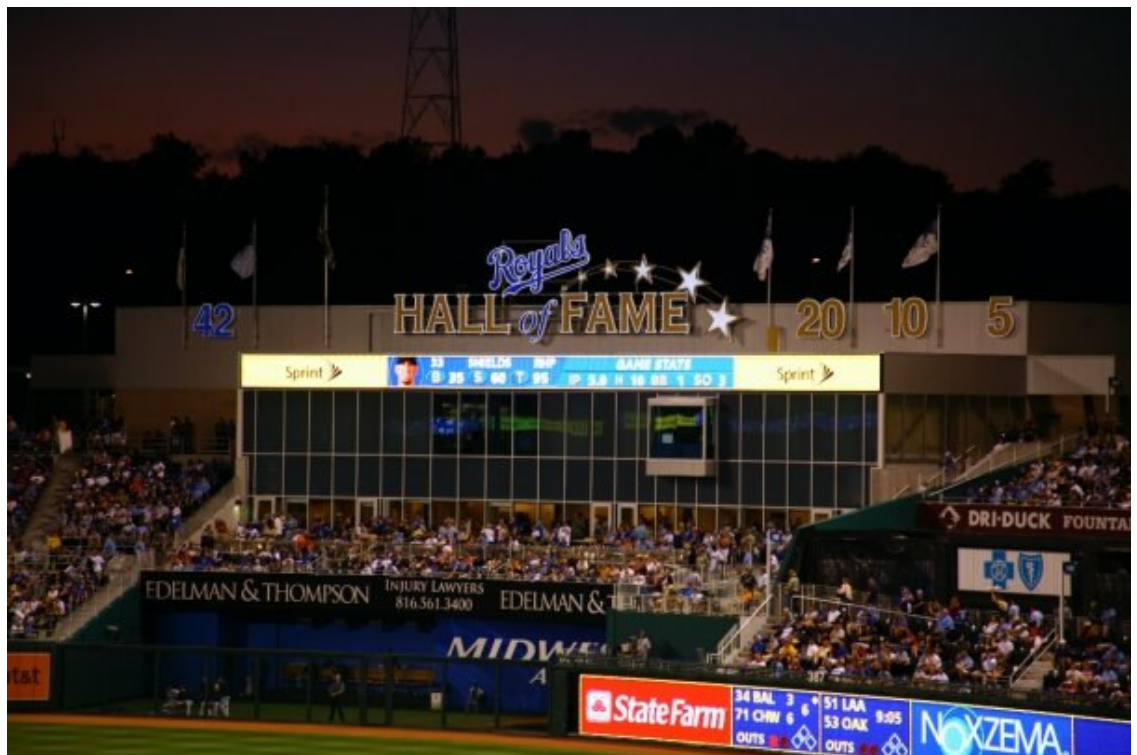

On July 17th, 2009, the Kansas City Royals opened the Hall of Fame located inside Kauffman Stadium. With this opening, it marks the official completion of renovations at Kauffman. The Royals Hall of Fame is an education and entertainment venue that blends the timelessness of a museum with the sheer fun of the ballpark for a one-of-a-kind outing at Kauffman Stadium. Exhibits include many artifacts, photos, documents and videos tracing the history of Kansas City Royals Baseball, along with unique multi-media interactive experiences.

Fans can learn about the Royals founding and the special story of the innovative Royals Baseball Academy. Get a better understanding of the role of player development and the minor leagues. Hear more about some of the greatest moments in Royals history from the inaugural 1969 season to today. Take a look back at the amazing careers of two of the greatest players to every play the game - George Brett and Frank White. 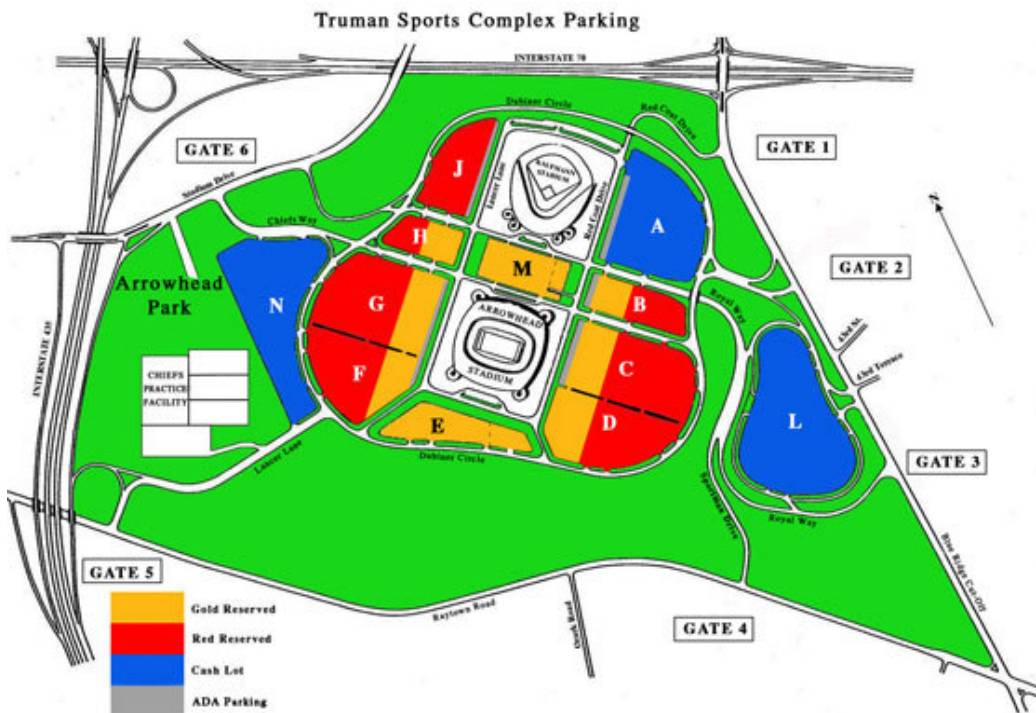

Information on stadium access will be updated as it becomes available. Take a moment to review this the website before heading out to the game.



Keep the following in mind when you visit Arrowhead this season: The stadium is still under construction and some of your favorite routes may not be available. Lots A, L & N are cash lots. Lots B, C, D, F, G, H and J are Red Reserve. Lots E and M, & portions of Lots B, C, D, F, & H are Gold Reserve. Remember, 1 vehicle per parking space, and parking passes do NOT guarantee a specific parking spot. The gates will open 3 1/2 hours prior to the start of the game. To avoid delays, please enter early.
